Dear High School Coach,

The Third annual 8th Grade All-Star game will be held on December 18th at 1:00pm at the new Erasmus Hall football field located at Avenue M and Macdonald Avenue. This year, Brooklyn/Queens will face Bronx/Manhattan in a battle of the boroughs, bringing together 70 to 80 of the top 8th Grade football players in the boroughs. The game is being presented under the sanction of AAU, one of the oldest and most respected amateur sports organizations in the country. Under the AAU sanction, all players and coaches are fully insured for practice and game activities.

We are seeking up to 6 coaches per team: (1) Head Coach, (2) Offensive Coordinator, (3) Defensive Coordinator, (4) Line Coach, (5) Defensive/Offensive Back Coach, and (6) linebacker Coach. Each coach is expected to pay a registration fee of \$25.00 and will receive: (1) a membership to AAU, (2) the general contact information for all participating players.
